Thanks to Sherry Otto, who attended my recent seminar on the Five Fundamentals of Lure Fishing for Speckled Trout, and came up with a great idea for enhancing Fishing Log entries. She pointed out how useful it would be to include a Google Map with each entry, referencing the specific spots fished. An icon could be added to each image before it is saved, then pasted into the log. I had already included a category for "relevant pics" in the Fishing Log template. Ideally, a new category could be created, something like "Google Maps" or whatever.

As Sherry rightly pointed out, using graphic images like these would accelerate the learning curve of the person creating the log, which is, after all, the point of keeping data in a format like this. Eventually, when places become more familiar to the log maker, creating a Google map for each entry would not be necessary. But while one is learning about a bay system or new areas within a familiar bay system, the inclusion of such images is a great idea. Thanks Sherry, for sharing!
