I recently received a jacket as a Christmas gift from Everett and Pam Johnson of *Texas Saltwater Fishing Magazine*. I'm loving the garment, which has found a niche in my winter apparel arsenal.

The jacket is offered by Mojo Sportswear Company. It's 100% polyester, which I find somewhat surprising. It feels more like a thin version of neoprene.

What I love about it is the way it feels and performs. It is windproof and waterproof, and has Velcro sleeves. I like to wear it under my fishing shirt on cold days. In the past, I'd always worn a fleece hoodie between my undergarments and my fishing shirt, but this jacket is much better, since it's thinner, less bulky, waterproof and tighter around the wrists with the sleeves cinched.

Wearing the Mojo jacket under my fishing shirt keeps me remarkably warm and dry, even if my arms dangle in the water. On warmer winter days, I can go with an undershirt, insulated shirt, the Mojo jacket and my fishing shirt. On the colder ones, I put my Simms jacket on over the fishing shirt. Then, I have two waterproof layers and two cinching sleeves.
