Longtime customer Jay Marek emailed recently with a link to an article which describes the spawning process for spotted seatrout. Per his request, I'm posting the web address here. I've covered this topic in articles in *TSFMag* before, but as I told Jay, I don't think the general public has a clear grasp on the nature of the reproductive habits of these fish. Mostly, people think of them as being like bass, but they are not, in any significant way, in terms of the way they procreate.
