Today, I'm proud and excited to introduce my newest video product. *Wing Nut's Quest* documents my 2014 birding Odyssey. I went out watching birds in the Port Aransas/Corpus Christi area many times this year, at some of the best sites in North America. Paradise Pond and the Leonabelle Turnbull Birding Center in Port Aransas both proved particularly productive.

I positively identified at least 200 species in the field and captured useful footage of many of them! In all, I shot over 5,000 video clips, in FULL HD. In addition to documenting the beauty and splendor of the various types of birds, I've attempted to give insight into the "essence of birding", as I've come to know it, and to illuminate aspects of the birds' behavior in my 71-minute movie. Mostly, I use spontaneous, on-site, real-time narration to enhance the images.

Among many amazing creatures, these found their way into my viewfinder this year: American Bittern, Least Bittern, Sora, Wilson's Snipe, Hooded Merganser, Glaucous Gull, Lesser Black-backed Gull, Lesser Black-backed/Herring Gull Hybrid, Yellow-billed Cuckoo, Groove-billed Ani, Pyrrhuloxia, Black-throated Blue Warbler, MacGillivray's Warbler, Swamp Sparrow and Marsh Wren.
