Fishing has been steadily excellent lately, particularly when generic summer conditions prevail. A calm lull in the early-morning hours creates good potential for a hot bite on Super Spook Juniors and sinking FatBoys. Most of the trout we're catching are coming from water about waist-deep or a bit shallower, with a hard, sandy bottom covered with scattered grass. The most productive spots lie fairly close to deep basins and channels. Overall, soft plastics account for more bites on most days, other than during the first two hours or so. We're landing good numbers of 19-24 inch trout, with a few larger ones, up to 28 inches and about seven pounds.
