Fishing has been pretty good this summer for bigger than average trout overall. Now, we are entering the time period when the hot water seems to make the fish sluggish (like the people) and it gets somewhat hard to pull monster trout from the depths. Not saying we won't find and catch some good ones over the next couple of months, given the improvement in the water quality.

I've completed two writing projects already this year, having just released my new book, Captain Kevin Cochran's Top 50 and also revised/added to my first book, Tricking Texas Trout. I plan on releasing the second edition of Tricking Texas Trout between now and the end of the year.
